1. **Robert Irwin-1.** He was born Abt. 1697. He died Bef. 10 Feb 1774 in Moree, Co. Tyrone<sup>[1]</sup>. Occupation was of Moree, Co. Tyrone.

Notes for Robert Irwin:

General Notes:

Moree (now spelt Morree) is a townland near Cookstown in the parish of Desertcreat and the electoral ward of Sandholes. The name probably also refers to the principal house of the district (and its lands). Moree was sold in 1818 to pay his debts on the death of Robert the younger, eldest son of Robert. A Robert Erwin married Margaret Young in 1721 in the Diocese of Clogher, which includes Drumglass and Moree - this might be our Robert's marriage [Irwin Marriages in Clogher and Armagh Dioceses].

The Londonderry Journal of 28/2/1775 gives an announcement that: Robert Irwin, of Moree, Gent. Sub-Sheriff of the County of Tyrone, will attend one Thursday at Dungannon, and the succeeding Thursday at Omagh, and so on alternating during the Year, beginning at Dungannon on Thursday the 2d of March; dated 24 Feb 1775

Thomas was a Freemason, registered as a member of lodge number 306, Banagher, King's County (now Co. Offaly) on 18 October 1842. Forced to sell Drumglass by his brother, the Rev Alex Staples Irwin he moved to Howard Terrace, Dungannon. In the 1901 census he is described as a magistrate and civil engineer.

**Lydia Simkins** is the daughter of Anthony Mann Simkins and Eliza Scott. She was born on 29 Mar 1821 in Great Easton, Essex <sup>[18]</sup>. Baptised on 29 Apr 1821 in St John and St Giles, Great Easton. She died on 15 Dec 1901 in Dungannon, Co. Tyrone <sup>[19]</sup>. Cause Of Death was Colic <sup>[20]</sup>.

Notes for Lydia Simkins:

General Notes:

Despite the 1901 census giving Lydia's age as 76 and her birthplace as London her birth and baptism were found in 1821 in Great Easton, Essex, where her father was Curate.

In 1843 Lydia was living at Capt Scott's in Banagher, King's County (now Co. Offaly) presumably a relative of her mother's.

There is a brass memorial tablet in Drumglass Parish Church (St Anne's, Dungannon) which includes the motto "nemo me impune lacessit" (the motto of the Order of the Thistle, meaning: no one provokes me with impunity) and reads: To the Glory of God | and sacred to the loving memory of our | precious mother, Lydia Irwin, wife of | Thomas Staples Irwin of Drumglass and | Daughter of the late Rev Anthony Mann Simkins | Chaplain to Her Majesty's Forces in India | Died 15th December 1901 | "And Ye now therefore have sorrow | but I will see you again and your | heart shall rejoice and your | joy no man taketh from you" | XVI of S. John, v. 22 | This tablet is erected by her devoted daughters. Lydia is buried along with husband Thomas and their son John in the Drumcoo cemetery in Dungannon (section E, plot 259).
